

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN THE CITIES OF WICKLIFFE, WILLOUGHBY AND WILLOWICK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Willowick, Wickliffe and Willoughby are adjoining municipal corporations within Lake County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Willowick, Wickliffe, and Willoughby agree that it is beneficial to each municipality to work collaboratively through the Ohio Department of Transportation and the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency’s Transportation Improvement Plan and the Federal Highway Infrastructure Improvement Plan/Community Project Funding in the resurfacing of Euclid Ave., which runs through each of the municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to share proportionally in their respective share of the total costs in accordance with the terms of the ODOT apportionment of construction costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized, on behalf of the City of Willowick, to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Willowick, City of Wickliffe and City of Willoughby, in a form substantially similar to the document annexed hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 123 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick.

Section 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick and further provides for the usual and necessary operating of the City of Willowick Engineering Department; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
