

RESOLUTION NO. 2026- 29

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE CALLWORKS NG9-1-1 SYSTEM CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS CONNECTIVITY, INC. FOR THE MIGRATION OF THE WILLOWICK POLICE DEPARTMENT'S 9-1-1 CALL HANDLING SYSTEM TO THE VESTA NXT PUBLIC CLOUD PLATFORM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Willowick, through the Willowick Police Department, currently utilizes the CallWorks NG9-1-1 System pursuant to an agreement dated September 24, 2020, with Motorola Solutions Connectivity, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions Connectivity, Inc. has proposed Amendment No. 1 to said agreement for the migration of the City's existing CallWorks NG9-1-1 System to the VESTA NXT Public Cloud platform; and

WHEREAS, the VESTA NXT Public Cloud platform is a cloud-based next-generation 9-1-1 call handling system intended to provide enhanced call processing, redundancy, interoperability, cybersecurity, and other emergency communications capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Amendment provides for a seven-year term with a total amended price of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), with the costs for 2026 and 2027 included at no additional charge and annual charges of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) for each of the years 2028 through 2032; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that entering into the proposed Amendment is necessary and appropriate to maintain and enhance the City's emergency 9-1-1 communications capabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into Amendment No. 1 to the CallWorks NG9-1-1 System Contract dated September 24, 2020, with Motorola Solutions Connectivity, Inc., substantially in the form presented to Council, for the migration of the Willowick Police Department's existing CallWorks NG9-1-1 System to the VESTA NXT Public Cloud platform, subject to approval as to legal form by the Law Director.

SECTION 2. The total amount payable by the City pursuant to Amendment No. 1 shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), consisting of no additional charge for calendar years 2026 and 2027 and annual charges not to exceed Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) for each calendar year 2028 through 2032, subject to the appropriation of funds by Council and the terms and conditions of the Amendment.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is further authorized to execute such additional documents as are reasonably necessary to implement Amendment No. 1, subject to approval as to legal form by the Law Director, provided that no such document shall increase the City's financial obligation or materially modify the City's contractual obligations without further authorization of Council.

SECTION 4. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payments pursuant to Amendment No. 1 from funds duly appropriated for that purpose and subject to certification in accordance with Section 5705.41 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 3.12 of the Charter of the City of Willowick and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick and for the further reason that the timely execution of Amendment No. 1 is necessary to maintain and transition the City's mission-critical 9-1-1 emergency communications system and to preserve the pricing offered by Motorola Solutions Connectivity, Inc.; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
