

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2026- 28**

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONCORD TOWNSHIP TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CITY OF WILLOWICK'S EXISTING SINGLE-HAULER SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH MAJOR WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES, INC., PURSUANT TO SECTION 9.48(B)(1) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Willowick has entered into a contract with Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc. for single-hauler solid waste and recycling collection services within the City; and

WHEREAS, Concord Township has requested permission to participate in the City's existing contract with Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc. pursuant to Section 9.48(B)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.48(B)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes a political subdivision to permit one or more other political subdivisions to participate in contracts into which it has entered for the acquisition of equipment, materials, supplies, or services; and

WHEREAS, Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc. has indicated its willingness to permit Concord Township to participate in the City's existing contract; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that permitting Concord Township to participate in the City's existing contract is appropriate and in the best interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 9.48(B)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Willowick hereby authorizes Concord Township to participate in the City's existing single-hauler solid waste and recycling services contract with Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc., subject to the consent of Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc. and upon such terms and conditions as may be separately agreed upon between Concord Township and Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc.

**SECTION 2.** Concord Township's participation in the City's contract shall not modify or otherwise adversely affect the rates, terms, services, rights, or obligations applicable to the City of Willowick under its existing contract with Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc.

**SECTION 3.** Concord Township shall be solely responsible for all costs, charges, fees, obligations, and liabilities arising from or related to services provided to Concord Township pursuant to its participation in the contract. Nothing contained in this Resolution shall obligate the City of Willowick to appropriate or expend any funds for services provided to Concord Township or otherwise create any financial obligation on behalf of the City arising from Concord Township's participation.

**SECTION 4.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such documents as may be reasonably necessary to acknowledge or effectuate Concord Township's participation in the City's contract with Major Waste Disposal Services, Inc., subject to approval as to legal form by the Law Director, provided that no such document shall increase the City's financial obligation or materially modify the City's rights or obligations under its existing contract without further authorization of Council.

**SECTION 5.** All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 3.12 of the Charter of the City of Willowick and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick and for the further reason that Concord Township has requested timely authorization to participate in the existing solid waste and recycling services contract; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
