

RESOLUTION NO. 3262

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOCATE COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027.

WHEREAS, the Community Enhancement Program (CEP) was created by Resolution No. 2543 in July 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Community Enhancement Program (CEP) was continued by Resolution No. 2897 in May 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Community Enhancement Program (CEP) accepted additional funding from Metro’s Community Investment Fee (CIF) by Resolution No. 3033 in January 2023; and

WHEREAS, Community Enhancement Program (CEP) and additional funding from Metro’s Community Investment Fee (CIF) was continued by Resolution No. 3268 in May 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Community Enhancement Program funding is used for “enhancing the host community of the facility from which the fees have been collected” to fund projects that “rehabilitate and enhance the area within the city”; and

WHEREAS, eligible projects can improve the appearance or environmental quality of the community, increase reuse and recycling opportunities or improve recreational areas and programs; and

WHEREAS, the annual Community Enhancement grant cycle was open from November 2025 – January 2026,

WHEREAS; a six members of the seven-member committee reviewed the applications to ensure that they comply with the program goals and criteria and made a recommendation to fund the following projects: Arts Culture and Heritage Commission Utility Box Public Art Project – ‘Celebrating the Arts’ Project (\$15,050), Charbonneau Community Foundation French Prairie Road Median Renewal Project (\$37,500), Tourism Promotion Committee Enhancing Wilsonville’s Biking Infrastructure Project (\$5,944), Wilsonville High School (WHS) ASB 2026 Dia de los Muertos Festival at WHS Project (\$12,000), Wilsonville Historical Society Growing Up in Wilsonville Book Reprint Project (\$3,000), Wilsonville Public Library Foundation Study Pods Project (\$24,810) be allocated in fiscal year 2026/27.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City allocates Community Enhancement Funds to the following project for Fiscal Year 2026/2027:

- Utility Box Public Art Project – ‘Celebrating the Arts’ - \$15,050

- French Prairie Road Median Renewal Project - \$37,500
- Enhancing Wilsonville's Biking Infrastructure Project - \$5,944
- 2026 Dia de los Muertos Festival at WHS Project - \$12,000
- Growing Up in Wilsonville Book Reprint Project - \$3,000
- Study Pods Project - \$24,810

Section 2: This resolution is effective upon adoption.
