August 2026 Report

The Administration Department supports the City Manager, City Council, and three committees. The department also includes communications, government affairs and records among many special projects. This report is intended to provide the City Council with monthly highlights that they may not receive otherwise.

- **City Recorder** received **41** public records request in August, of which only two (2) were from Wilsonville Residents.
- **Code Compliance:** Received eight (8) complains from the “Ask the City” customer relationship management (CRM). Common complaints were regarding abandoned vehicle, tall grass, and signage.
- **Committees:**
 - Wilsonville’s Diversity Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Committee did not meet in August. The DEI Las Posadas and Juneteenth subcommittees met to discuss their upcoming 2026-27 events.
 - Wilsonville-Metro Community Enhancement Committee and the Tourism Promotion Committee did not meet in August.
- **Communications:** Dates are confirmed and begun promotional activities for fall Shred Day (Oct. 3), Bulky Waste Day (Oct. 17), and Leaf Drop Day (Nov. 21)
 - Most views on Facebook in August – Movie in the Park: Hopper – 31.7K Views (Image above)
 - WilsonvilleOregon.gov captured 125.4K views. The top webpages visited was the Library, Home Page, and Traffic Cameras.
 - Let’sTalkWilsonville.com captured 1,009 views. The top traffic channel was Direct, indicating that most visitors accessed the website by navigating to it directly.
- **Public Affairs:**
 - Submitted a petition to withdraw areas surrounding Wilsonville from the TriMet district. The goal is to align current and future city limits with the SMART service area.
 - Willamette Falls and Landings Heritage Area Coalition has been working to reintroduce federal legislation to establish a National Heritage Area. The coalition has been engaging federally-recognized tribes who have an interest or history at/near Willamette Falls.
- **Volunteers:** City Volunteers were invited to attend a volunteer appreciation event at the Party in the Park event on August 20, 2026, at 5:30pm.
