Vuela Grand Opening (May 27)

On May 27th beginning at 10:00 AM, the City, in partnership with Palindrome Development, will hold a grand opening and ribbon cutting for Vuela, Wilsonville's newly built transit-oriented development.

Vuela includes 121 new housing units, most of which are reserved for individuals/families earning 30-80% Area Median Income (AMI), with some units reserved for households earning 0-30% AMI. The event will include remarks from federal, state, and local elected officials and project partners -- building tours and refreshments will be offered.
