COMMITTEE DISCUSSION & DECISION

There was discussion about Heart of the City of Wilsonville and Watching Wilsonville’s Wildlife project proposals. There was additional discussion, needed clarification and questions with regards to Heart of the City of Wilsonville, including:

- Not clear on the project. Suggest reaching out to Clackamas County to seek supportive ways of available funding.
- This organization is incredible and do great things for the community.
- Premature in the process. Work with the City for plans and permits. Timeline for permits and plans was not clear.
- Encouraged to reapply in FY 24-25 with a clear project and exhaust all other funding options. Suggest providing a letter from the County stating funds are available for this project.
- Be specific on the cost for the project and what portion will be used by CEP.
- Need clear scope for the project.

There was also a brief discussion about possible funding that might be available for Watching Wilsonville's Wildlife through the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Maripat made a motion to recommend City Council approve the following FY 23-24 Community Enhancement Grants.

- Friends of the Library Book Bike - \$6,250.
- ACHC Memorial Park Skate Park Mural - \$20,000.
- Murase Arboretum - \$13,000.
- Watching Wilsonville Wildlife - \$18,914.

Total allocation of \$58,164.

Councilor Berry seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
