SLEIGHT OF HAND JEWELRY THEIVES

Several counties in the area, including Clackamas, have been hit by a pair of suspects stealing jewelry using a sleight of hand technique.

The couple, a male and female thought to be in their late 50s or 60s, have been associated with multiple vehicles, most commonly a newer white SUV. The male has been the driver. He stops in front of the victim's home or pulls up next to their car in a parking lot. The female gets out and, speaking with a thick middle-eastern accent, begins talking about her country's traditions and may begin to drape fake jewelry on her mark. She'll focus on rings or watches, eventually maneuvering the jewelry off her victim and into a sock, which she then tightly ties, blesses, and gives to her target.

When the victim, who has not been successful shaking the female from contact, eventually gets into the sock, the couple have fled and they find themselves left with fake jewelry. To-date, more than \$150k has been lost to this couple in the Wilsonville area.



