Wilsonville Police and the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office are actively investigating the disappearance of Katheryn Gerke, a Wilsonville resident last seen in the Villebois area on March 26.

We've followed up on several tips about possible sightings but have not yet located her. If you have any information about Gerke's whereabouts or believe you've seen her, please contact non-emergency dispatch at 503-655-8211.

A women's heart shaped silver ring with diamond inlays was recovered from a Wilsonville Park during February of this year.
