PROPOSED PROGRAMS:

Tip Rewards Program



- \$250 reward for people who provide report vandalism, leading to arrest
 - Limited to cost of damage if less than \$250
 - City discretion to offer higher reward
- Qualifying Information
- Claim for reward must be filed within 90 days

Graffiti Subsidization



- Residents apply for reimbursement for supplies purchased or subsidization on professional removal services
- City pays half of supplies cost or half of lowest bid for services

Removal Loaner Kits



- Full loaner kit with removal supplies available for resident pick up and return
