ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:

Government Relations and our contract government affairs consultant, Greg Leo of The Leo Co., will share a recap of the 2026 Legislative Session. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The 2026 Legislative Session convened on February 2, 2026 and adjourned *sine die* on March 6, 2026, two days before the maximum allowed by the Oregon Constitution. The City of Wilsonville, with the assistance of The Leo Co. as our contracted government affairs consultant and in partnership with the League of Oregon Cities and other statewide lobby associations, advanced the Council adopted legislative agenda and engaged on issues relevant to the City of Wilsonville.

The 2026 Legislative Session Report (Attachment A) provides a recap of items included on our State Legislative Agenda, bills of importance to Wilsonville, and major themes and takeaways of the session including state budget adjustments.
