MAYOR'S BUSINESS

1. City Council Vacancy

The Mayor explained included in the City Council packet was a memo outlining the historical approaches prior Councils have taken when filling a vacancy. The City of Wilsonville Charter gave the authority to appoint by majority, but it did not set out a single procedure.

Council expressed gratitude for former Councilor Dunwell's service to the City of Wilsonville.

Council and staff discussion ensued over the appointment process and application.

Motion: Moved to approve the edited version of the Mayor's proposal to the City Council regarding the appointment process.

The City Attorney clarified the edits were on item number one of the application period changing submitted to received by.

Councilor Cunnigham suggested striking on the appointment application number nine from the memo.

To allow for further refinement and discussion Council President Berry withdrew her motion.
