Background/Information:

The Harvest Fest is a family friendly event that the City of Wilsonville's Parks and Recreation Department puts on. Elements at the event include live music, library story time, crafts, free pumpkins, costume parade, horse and carriage rides, face painters, and more.

In 2023 staff added an arts/makers vendor market. Staff invited approximately 20 vendors to participate.

For 2024, over 60 applications were received. Staff can accommodate approximately 35 vendors due to capacity, spacing, etc.

While not every vendor is unique (multiple sell the same type of goods) the ACHC should consider variety, skill, and whether or not they think they will they will make sales.

Event Details:

 What: A family friendly seasonal festival with music, pumpkins, crafts, horse and carriage rides, face painting, a costume parade and more!

- When: Saturday, October 19th from 10am-1pm
- Where: Stein-Boozier Barn, located in Murase Plaza.

Vendor Details:

- Cost: Each vendor who is selected to participate will need to pay a \$30 vendor fee. Checks can be
 made out to the City of Wilsonville and mailed or dropped off to the Parks and Rec Admin Office
 at 29600 SW Park Place due prior to the event date. Vendors will be notified of acceptance or
 refusal by September 23rd
- Setup: Each vendor is responsible for providing their own:
 - o POS system, or way to take in payments (square, paypal, venmo, etc...)
 - o 6-8'table and tablecloth
 - 10'x10' canopy tent (or smaller)
 - It is the responsibility of each vendor to provide their own set-up and take-down of materials
