## Wilsonville Wildcats Week Proclamation June 6-10, 2022

WHEREAS, Wilsonville residents honor the faculty and administration of Wilsonville High School for providing a well-rounded education that includes extra-curricular activities that aid in the development of life skills, and;

**WHEREAS**, The Wilsonville Wildcats Girls Varsity Soccer team is representative of the High School's commitment to sportsmanship, excellence and personal development, and;

WHEREAS, These Wildcats have showed off their considerable skills not just on the field, but in the classroom. The team's cumulative grade point average of 3.92 earned them the Oregon School Activities Association's academic all-state award for highest GPA, and;

WHEREAS, This 2021 Wildcat team finished the season as Northwest Oregon Conference Champions, posting an undefeated season with 18 wins and one tie in 19 matches;

WHEREAS, The team extended its overall unbeaten streak to 30 games, after a perfect 11-0-0 shortened season in 2020;

**WHEREAS**, Wilsonville's dominant offense (97 goals scored) was matched only by its equally dominant defense and goaltending (9 goals allowed) and;

**WHEREAS**, This unstoppable squad scored nearly 11 goals for every goal they allowed and shut out their opponents on 12 occasions, and;

WHEREAS, Six Wildcats players were recognized as members of the all-State team, and;

WHEREAS, Ten players received first-team, second-team or honorable mention all-league honors, and;

WHEREAS, Senior Lindsey Antonson was named Girls Soccer Player of the Year at the 2021 Oregon Sports Awards, and;

WHEREAS, Antonson now holds the Oregon record for most goals scored (139) in her high school career, and leaves the program as three-time Conference Player of the Year, two-time 5A Player of the Year and two-time State Championship Player of the Game, and;

**WHEREAS**, On Saturday, November 13, 2021, under the guidance of head coaches Alex Boehm and Dallas Malone, the Wilsonville High School Girls Varsity soccer team captured a 4-2 win over Crescent Valley, and;

WHEREAS, This Wildcats Girls Varsity soccer team displayed exemplary sportsmanship and dominant play against 5A competition. Their success on the field and in the classroom generated positive attention, excitement and community pride, while serving as an example and inspiration to the Wilsonville community.
