

RESOLUTION NO. 3277

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GOODS AND SERVICES CONTRACT WITH VIA MOBILITY, LLC FOR DEPLOYMENT OF MOBILITY ECO-SYSTEM CAD-AVL PLANNING AND PASSENGER INFORMATION SYSTEM FOR SMART FLEET OPERATIONS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City has planned and budgeted for the update in hardware and software design for SMART technology necessary for operation of public transit services (the Project); and,

WHEREAS, the City solicited proposals from qualified consultants for the Project that duly followed Federal Transit Administration Contracting Rules, the State of Oregon Public Contracting Rules and the City of Wilsonville Municipal Code; and,

WHEREAS, seven proposals were received on March 12, 2026, with three proposals advancing to the interview phase of the selection process; and,

WHEREAS, Via Mobility, LLC submitted a proposal for the Project, and the City subsequently negotiated with the proposer a three-year with two one-year options agreement for \$759,187, of which \$499,687 is for one-time implementation costs and \$259,500 for Software as a Service (SaaS) subscription and licensing services; and,

WHEREAS, at the City's option, additional services and licenses may be purchased by Task Orders, not to exceed \$250,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The procurement process for the Project duly followed Federal Transit Administration and Oregon Public Contracting Rules, and Via Mobility, LLC has provided a responsive and responsible proposal for professional services;
- Section 2. The City of Wilsonville, acting as the Local Contract Review Board, authorizes the City Manager to enter into and execute, on behalf of the City of Wilsonville, a professional services agreement with Via Transportation, Inc. for a stated not-to-exceed value of \$1,009,187 (\$759,187 + \$250,000 option) in substantially the form as attached hereto as Exhibit A;
- Section 3. The City of Wilsonville, acting as the Local Contract Review Board, authorizes the City Manager to enter into and execute, on behalf of the City of Wilsonville, future reimbursement agreement(s) with Ride Clackamas participants to make operational and planning software available to local transit providers; and

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
