- Encourage economic stimulus through cultural tourism


Field Guide




- The field guide will be 100-125 page print publication divided into chapters, such as geology, parks, cultural history, habitats, and wildlife.
- A consultant, with experience in publishing field guides, will manage the project and sub-consultants (e.g., designer, proofreader, publisher).
- Contributors will include subject matter experts and individuals with local knowledge and expertise
- The initial printing will be 100 copies, including an eBook version.
- The field guide will be available in the Wilsonville library, school libraries, other locations, and provided at various public events.
- The total cost for the project is \$19,500, which will be completed within one year.
