

**Announcement Regarding Boone Bridge Testimony at JWM  
City Council February 2, 2026**

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means of the State Legislature is holding a public hearing tomorrow on proposed agency reductions to balance the state's budget. Part of the proposed reductions includes clawing back \$108,000 from the \$1 million Senator Courtney Neron-Misslin secured for the project last year. I will be down in Salem testifying in support of keeping that funding whole since it is crucial to our effort to secure federal funding.

All members of the public are welcome to testify at the hearing, and I encourage Wilsonville residents to show their support for the Boone Bridge Replacement Project. The meeting will be in Hearing Room 40 in the Oregon State Capitol in Salem from 5:00 – 8:00 PM. Testimony is limited to 1-2 minutes and can be done in person or virtually. You can also submit written testimony.
