

RESOLUTION NO. 3101

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ABSCO SOLUTIONS FOR THE CARD ACCESS AND SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEM AT THE LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the City currently utilizes a card access system at City facilities to manage physical door security and access; and

WHEREAS, the current card access system is nearing the end of its useful life and has significant maintenance issues; and

WHEREAS, it is most efficient and cost effective to utilize the same card access and camera system at the Library as installed at the new Public Works Complex;

WHEREAS, the installation of additional cameras at the Library will provide enhanced security and improve safety for staff and customers;

WHEREAS, the City the project is included in the FY 23/24 budget; and

WHEREAS, Absco Solutions and the City of Wilsonville have negotiated a contract for the purchase of the new card access and camera system.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Wilsonville, acting as the Local Contract Review Board, authorizes the City Manager to enter into and execute, on behalf of the City of Wilsonville, a contract with Absco Solutions for a stated value of \$149,405.49 which contract must be substantially similar to Attachment 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein.
2. This Resolution becomes effective upon adoption.
