Current Nuisance Code Review and Proposed Updates

- Focus: Noxious Vegetation, Property Appearance, Noise, and Other Chronic Nuisances
- Noise Regulations Are Well-Developed
 - 7 Factors
 - Enumerated (But Not Exhaustive) List of 11 Categories of Nuisance Noises
 - Exemptions and Exceptions Articulated
- Noxious Vegetation/Property Appearance Update
 - Of Cities Reviewed, Clearer Standards in Tualatin, Beaverton, and West Linn
 - Model After Noise Regulations and Other Cities
- Enforcement
 - House Enforcement in Chapter 1 with Planned Update
