The size of the "quilt" squares will be approximately 8". There will be a total of about 38 squares, each with a different image.


The "back" of the heart will look the same as the front but with different images in each quilt square.




Artist response:

The ones of the front represent French, Early American, Mexican, Chinese, Japanese, Indian, Norwegian, African, Hawaiian, Australian, Swedish, German and Polish. It's difficult to see the exact images since they are so small on the 8 1/2 x 11.

I plan to include Native American, South American, Russian, Eastern European, SE Asian, a penguin for Antarctica and a polar bear for the Arctic Circle!"
