ISSUE BEFORE AGENCY:

A supplemental budget resolution for the fiscal year 2024-2025 budget year.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Oregon's Local Budget Law allows the Urban Renewal Agency (URA) Board to amend the adopted budget for an occurrence or condition that was not known at the time the budget was adopted. The fiscal year (FY) 2024-2025 budget was adopted by the Agency on June 3, 2024.

Budget Adjustment Resolution

This supplemental budget includes:

(1) CIP Rollovers:

The re-appropriation of funds from the prior fiscal year capital improvement projects (CIPs) that were started but not completed in that fiscal year. These requests are attributable to multi-year projects approved by the Board. Although overall contracts are not exceeded, a budget supplemental request is needed to roll the balance of these contracts from one fiscal year to the next, due to timing differences of when work is performed. The CIP rollover request of \$1,601,801 is for direct costs, as detailed in **Attachment 1**.

This includes:

- a. Boeckman Dip Bridge (CIP 4212) \$1,454,120
- b. Brown Road Improvements (CIP 4216) \$147,681

EXPECTED RESULTS:

The Urban Renewal Districts are required to amend their respective annual budget in accordance with Oregon local budget law. It is required to have the supplemental budget adjustment approved by the Board during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting.

TIMELINE:

As required by Local Budget Law, a notice for the public hearing has been published in the Wilsonville Spokesman on September 26, 2024. The adoption of the Supplemental Budget Adjustment is required prior to the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2025.

CURRENT YEAR BUDGET IMPACTS:

See detail outlined in Exhibit A.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROCESS:

The public hearing will be held on October 7, 2024, as a part of the adoption process.

POTENTIAL IMPACTS OR BENEFIT TO THE COMMUNITY:

The amended budget provides for the delivery of services and construction of capital projects throughout the community.

ALTERNATIVES:

Not approving the attached supplemental budget could result in overspending current budget appropriations. The City is required to disclose all excess expenditures over appropriations in the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).
