URA RESOLUTION NO. 361

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY
TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP OF LAND TO THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE.**

WHEREAS, in or about 1990, the City of Wilsonville (“City”) and the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Wilsonville (“Agency”) established the Year 2000 Plan to form an urban renewal district to help fund significant infrastructure, parks and recreation amenities, facilities, and school partnership projects; and

WHEREAS, in October 2007, the Agency, through implementation of the Year 2000 Plan, purchased a greenfield site east and north of 30000 Town Center Loop East (the current location of the City’s Police Department); and

WHEREAS, following the closure of the Thunderbird Mobile Home Park, the Agency partnered with the nonprofit, NW Housing Alternatives, Inc., to develop affordable senior housing on the portion of the property owned by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, a successor entity to NW Housing Alternatives, Inc. – Creekside Woods Limited Partnership – entered into a 99-year Master Ground Lease with the Agency to finance and construct the affordable senior housing project; and

WHEREAS, since construction, Creekside Woods Apartments, located at 7825 SW Wilsonville Road, Wilsonville, Clackamas County, Oregon (the “Property”), has provided affordable multifamily senior housing in Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, effective June 30, 2023 the Year 2000 urban renewal district ceased collecting all increment collections; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Agency seek to transfer ownership of the Property from the Agency to the City and to assign to the City all rights and obligations of the Agency under the Master Ground Lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The above-stated recitals and the staff report accompanying this Resolution are incorporated as the Urban Renewal Agency's findings as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The Urban Renewal Agency hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Quit Claim Deed to transfer the Property to the City of Wilsonville, which Quit Claim Deed is substantially similar to **Exhibit A** attached hereto, to assign the Master Ground Lease to the City of Wilsonville, and to take any and all steps necessary to close the transaction with the City of Wilsonville.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
