

The Committee of the Whole of the Village of Winnebago met on May 13, 2024, at 7:05 p.m. while taking a break from the Board Meeting with President Eubank presiding.

No one stated a conflict of interest.

Public Comment: Michelle McDonald, owner of The Post, stated she is in favor of the Pedal Bus proposed by Robb Firch. She noted that it is a small business bringing something new to the Village.

Robb Firch said others interested in bringing this to the Village are Carrie Woolbright from The Scoop, Aaron Booker, County Board Member and Amber Mangiaracina from Bago Lounge. He noted only canned refreshments (no hard liquors) would be allowed. The trips would be about two hours and would be during daylight hours. Most Board Members were in favor of drafting an ordinance to work through all needed details.

Golf Carts: There was a great deal of discussion about the safety of golf carts. Golf Carts will have the same requirements as the U.T.V’s.

Bill Hoyt suggested putting a notice in the paper that golf carts and U.T.V’s are legal in the Village.

3. Elected Official Compensation: Mr. Dienberg provided suggested increases for the elected officials after the next election. The Trustees concurred with the suggested increases. Mr. Dienberg will draft an Ordinance and present it at the June meeting.
