EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Village of Winnebago intends to proceed with the in-house construction of the Clayton Court water main loop, transitioning from the previously considered bid process. This decision follows completion of engineering design and aims to achieve cost savings and maintain control over construction quality.

The scope of work includes the directional boring and fusing of an 8" HDPE water main line from Soper Street to Cunningham Road. Kelsey Excavating, Inc. will perform specialized boring under Clayton Court and from Cunningham Road under the creek, with quoted costs totaling \$37,000. Materials for the project will be sourced based on a quote from Core & Main, totaling approximately \$31,754.50. The total estimated construction cost remains under the \$80,000 not-to-exceed threshold.

The Clayton Court and Cunningham corridors have been a major source of water main breaks as well, costing village resources with each incident.

A formal resolution authorizing this shift to in-house construction and allocation of funds will be presented for approval.
