EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Village of Winnebago Police Department at times replaces vehicles that are beyond their financially feasible service life. By evaluating repair costs, vehicle mileage and vehicle condition, those vehicles that meet the established criteria for replacement are taken out of service and either sold via sealed bid or sold directly to an interested party.

The 2013 Ford Taurus (VIN 1FAHP2M8EDG116934) which is owned by the Village has met the criteria for replacement. An outside party has expressed interest in purchasing this vehicle in the amount of \$2,800.00 According to the National Automobile Dealers Association (NADA) the value of this vehicle based on mileage, vehicle options and vehicle condition, is estimated to range between \$2,000 and \$3,000.

With the offer from the interested party being above the mid-range of the NADA estimated value of this vehicle, it is recommended that this vehicle be sold to interested party for the price of \$2,800.00 to not only receive the best price for the sale of said vehicle, but to also avoid a drawn out process of obtaining sealed bid for the vehicle that may or may not reach the offered price of \$2,800.

I therefore recommend this surplus equipment be sold to Metro Enforcement for the agreed upon amount of \$2,800.00
