| At their last meeting on September 10, 2025, the Liquor Commission discussed the preliminary concept of a self-serve "tap wall" proposed by the owner of the upcoming Table Talk Supper Club. Village Administrator Joey Dienberg and Attorney Mary Gaziano shared initial research, including potential practices from other Illinois municipalities and other recommendations. Key points included: use of RFID or bracelet systems for ID verification and pour tracking, BASSET-trained staff presence, pour limits per customer, and concerns over monitoring alcohol consumption. The owner of the business was invited but did not attend the meeting. There was consensus that more information is required, particularly from the business owner, to determine whether regulatory changes, such as ordinance amendments, would be necessary. |  |
