ORDINANCE 2026-003

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITIONS OF MAYOR, COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 1 AND COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 2 IN THE MAY 2, 2026, CITY ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELING THE ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has called for an election on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing the mayor and two councilmembers;

WHEREAS, the councilmembers are elected at large by place with the candidate(s) who receives the highest number of votes filling the vacant position;

WHEREAS, there is one candidate running for the position of Councilmember Place 1, one candidate running for the position of Councilmember Place 2, and one candidate running for the position of Mayor;

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy and that there is one candidate for Mayor, one candidate for Councilmember Place 1, and one candidate for Councilmember Place 2; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Texas Election Code, authorizes the City Council to declare the Mayor, Councilmember Place 1 and Councilmember Place 2 elected to office and cancel the election; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOLFFORTH, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 2, 2026 City election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued a certificate of election following the time the election would have been canvassed.

Mayor: Charles Addington, II
Councilmember Place 1: Brandon R. Tyler
Councilmember Place 2: Robert Salazar

Section 2. That the May 2, 2026, City election is canceled. The City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of the Order of Cancellation (attached hereto as Exhibit A) to be posted on election day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

Section 3. It is declared to be the intent of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance is declared invalid by the judgment of decree of

a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance since the city council would have enacted them without the invalid portion.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, and it is so ordained.
