### **BACKGROUND:**

The Don Black Tiger Relays Track Meet will take place at Peoples Bank stadium in February 2026. Frenship Track will host 25+ teams from the region at this annual meet. In past years, HOT funds have been used to purchase coaches' gifts and as a donation to the Track Booster Club to help with expenses related to this event. The requested amount is the same as last year, \$4,000. This has been a long-standing request for support for this regional track meet.

Under Texas law, local HOT revenue can be used only to directly promote tourism and the convention/hotel industry. This means the proceeds should be spent on projects or events that result in visitors or attendees staying overnight in the community, generating more hotel occupancy tax. With the expected attendance of so many regional teams, this event is eligible for funding.
