As you will recall, one of the projects on our Water Capital Improvements Plan is the construction of the Lubbock Water North Interconnect. Within the past few weeks you will remember you discussed the type of fencing to be constructed around this site. A Proposal has been submitted by Utility Contractors of America in the amount of \$2,977,240.00 for this project, which consists of the interconnection to a Lubbock water main along Alcove Avenue, a Metering Vault, 500,000-gallon Ground Storage Tank and foundation, Pump Station, all associated Piping, backup power, a Perimeter Security Fence and all-weather surfacing of the area inside the fence. The tank will be white with no graphics or logo.

As per our water purchase contract with the City of Lubbock, this project needs to be complete on or before June 1, 2026. Mr. Jonathan Ziegner with UCA has informed us that he believes this project can be completed in advance of that deadline. If awarded the contract, UCA is prepared to begin work immediately.

Funding for this project comes from the 2024 Certificates of Obligation.
