

ORDINANCE 2026-009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOLFFORTH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 6, HEALTH AND SANITATION, ARTICLE 6.02.56 PROHIBITED MATERIALS BY ADDING DIRT AND SOD; PROVIDING A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, to facilitate the removal of waste that cannot be disposed of through normal solid waste service and to encourage proper disposal of such waste, the City will maintain and operate a bulky waste facility (the “Facility”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wolfforth finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Wolfforth to add dirt and sod to the Prohibited Materials list;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOLFFORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1. Enacted.

THAT the City of Wolfforth Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending Chapter 6 Health and Sanitation, Article 6.02.56 Prohibited Materials, which shall read as follows:

ARTICLE 6.02 GARBAGE REGULATIONS

§ 6.02.56 Prohibited Materials.

The following are strictly prohibited, and disposal of these items is punishable as set forth in § 6.02.57:

- All types of waste generated by stores, offices, restaurants, warehouses, and other commercial activities
- All types of waste generated by manufacturing or industrial activities
- All types of waste generated by agricultural activities
- White Goods (refrigerators, air conditioners, etc.)
- Tires of any size
- Household hazardous waste (paints, solvents, pesticides)
- Construction/demolition debris
- Regular household refuse (kitchen garbage)
- Batteries
- Shingles
- Dirt and Sod

(unapproved draft)

Part 2. Severability

The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be independent, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

Part 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict with this Ordinance.

Part 4. Open Meetings Act

This meeting was open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required

Part 5. Publication

The City Secretary is authorized and direct to publish the caption and penalty prescribed by this Ordinance in accordance with State Law.

Part 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its publication.
