**SUMMARY / HISTORY**

The City had its roads paved in late 2023 and the Panel's goal is to preserve those roads by possibly updating Chapter 92 in the City's Code of Ordinances.

Only one section §92.08(D) specifically states that boring under the City's roads is required.

Other sections of the Ordinance may need to be clarified with specific language regarding the repairing of roads, if a cut is required. As of now, the language reads roughly to repair "as good or better condition than existed before the work". This language can be found on §92.3(B), §92.05(B)(1), §92.07(B) and (C), §92.07(1)(2) and §92.07(E)(2).

Without a specific width for repair, there is no standard. Freeland Turk has offered to review the existing Ordinance for the Panel to create this standard.



**RECOMMENDATION:**


