Subject

Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2025-11(R) authorizing the City of Wylie to enter into an Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with the City of Mesquite, and authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents.

Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

Discussion

The City of Wylie is authorized to purchase from a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or a local cooperative organization pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Section 271 Subchapter F of the Local Government Code.

By doing so, the City of Wylie satisfies State Law requiring local governments to seek competitive bids for goods and services, as these items have already been competitively bid by another local government or local cooperative organization.

The City of Mesquite currently has contracts with various vendors for goods and services, and Wylie has a need for same and desires to enter into an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement with the City of Mesquite.

Due to the purchasing volumes from larger government entities and cooperative groups, the City is able to achieve cost savings that may not be available as a stand-alone entity through the competitive bid process.

Staff recommends the approval of an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement between the City of Wylie and the City of Mesquite as highly beneficial to maintain cost beneficial goods and services.
