Subject

Consider, and act upon, Ordinance No. 2023-33 amending Wylie's Code of Ordinances, Ordinance No. 2021-17, as amended, Chapter 98 (Solid Waste), Article I (In General), Section 98-2 (Definitions), and Article II (Junkyard; Salvage Yards), Section 98-21 (Residential Collection – Regulations), Section 98-23 (Residential Collection – Regulations), and Section 98-24 (Residential Collection – Fees for unusual collection); providing for a penalty for the violation of this Ordinance; providing for repealing, savings and severability clauses; providing for an effective date of this Ordinance; and providing for the publication of the caption of this Ordinance.

Recommendation

Discussion

Chapter 98 (Solid Waste) Ordinance was last amended in 2011. The provisions in the current Ordinance are not updated to reflect or allow for the City's new bulk program. This amendment is updated to reflect the definition of non-compliance so the customer can better understand what is acceptable bulk, sizing, and placement of bulk items eligible for pickup. This amendment also reflects Residential Collection Regulations. This amendment will eliminate the customer being able to leave non-compliant bulk items on the curb longer than the weekend allowed. Failure for the customer to remove brush and bulk waste in non-compliance will result in the City causing such to be removed. Costs for bulk removal will be agreed upon by the CWD and City staff and assessed against the property passed onto the utility account holder and/or owner of the property.
