### Subject

Consider, and act upon, the award of Request for Bids No. W2026-17 to establish a one (1) year service price agreement with three (3) one-year renewal options for Citywide Concrete Services to GT Construction in an estimated annual amount of \$850,000.00 for the Public Works Department, and authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents.

### Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

### Discussion

The Public Works Department is seeking Council approval to award Request for Bids No. W2026-17 to GT Construction for Citywide Concrete Services. Contractor must furnish all necessary materials, machinery, equipment, fuel, labor, and superintendence for services related to concrete and asphalt pavement, as well as new construction of concrete structures such as retaining walls, steps, or sidewalks. Materials and workmanship must conform to the highest standards of industry practice.

Work included through this procurement may include the removal, replacement, and/or installation of concrete streets, sidewalks, drive approaches, parking lots, medians, alleys, retaining walls, curbs, gutters, and barrier-free sidewalk ramps. Examples of such services for the previous fiscal year included:

- Curb and Gutter Repairs
- Concrete Pavement Repairs, Markings, and Striping
- Asphalt Pavement Repairs
- New Concrete Construction, Sidewalk Construction, and Barrier-Free Ramp Construction
- Crack and Joint Sealing
- Pavement Seal Coat
- Sub-Grade Repairs and Construction

For competitive bids, an award recommendation is made for the vendor based on the lowest competitive quoted price, who is also technically and financially capable of performing and completing the contract, and otherwise meets all material specification requirements. Negotiations are not allowed.

The City completed a competitive sealed bid process in alignment with Local Government Code, Chapter 252. As part of the solicitation process and in an effort to increase competition, Purchasing utilized its e-Procurement platform to notify vendors registered under relevant commodity codes. The bid was also advertised in the Wylie News. Eight (8) submittals were received by the Purchasing Department. Upon tabulating bid pricing, a due diligence review was conducted.

Staff recommends the award of Request for Bids No. W2026-17 for Citywide Concrete Services to GT Construction in an estimated annual amount of \$850,000.00 for the Public Works Department, as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder providing the best value to the City.

This action does not encumber funds; the purpose of this agreement is to establish firm pricing for services and goods, for a specific term, which are ordered on an as needed basis according to annual budgetary appropriations. The estimated amount is intended as guidance rather than a cap on spending under the agreement, so that actual need combined with the amount budgeted will determine the amount spent.
