Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2026-09(R) authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Wylie and Collin County for cost-sharing the design of Kreymer Lane widening and improvements from Crescent Oak to State Highway 78.

Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

Discussion

The City of Wylie is requesting to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Collin County to facilitate the design of Kreymer Lane and Troy Road from State Highway 78 to Crescent Oak. This project will be managed by the City. The total cost of the design portion of this project is \$3,163,380. The County agrees to pay the City \$1,598,869.39 for the design of the roadway and improvements that are located in the County's jurisdiction. Additionally, the County has agreed to fund \$1,928,000.00 to acquire the necessary right-of-way for this project.

This project was previously considered and approved by the North Texas Council of Governments and the Regional Transportation Council to receive federal funding for design and construction, with anticipated disbursements starting in late 2028/early 2029 timeframe. To help accelerate the project schedule, the City elected to remove the design phase from federal funding, allowing design to move forward ahead of those federal funds becoming available.

This Interlocal Agreement was brought before the Commissioners Court on April 27, 2026, and was approved.
