Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2021-46(R) opposing the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) application for a proposed wastewater treatment facility located 0.4 miles northwest of the intersection of North Murphy Road and Rolling Ridge Drive in Collin County, Texas near the cities of Murphy, Parker, and Wylie. TCEQ Permit No. WQ0016003001

Recommendation

Discussion

City Council members have been contacted by citizens of the Rolling Ridge Subdivision in Murphy, as well as surrounding areas to express their concern with the proposed wastewater treatment plant submitted by Restore the Grasslands LLC and Harrington/Turner Enterprises, LP. The cities of Murphy and Parker have adopted resolutions to oppose the plant.

Permit No. WQ0016003001 has been submitted to TCEQ for a proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 200,000 gpd. The domestic wastewater treatment facility will be located approximately 0.4 miles northwest of the intersection of North Murphy Road and Rolling Ridge Drive in Collin County. The specific location is located within Parker's ETJ, and sits approximately 1.06 miles from Wylie's nearest residential subdivision.

Staff has obtained a copy of the documents presented to the Murphy City Council, including letters from Texas Senator Angela Paxton and Texas Representative Candy Noble to TCEQ requesting a public meeting be held in the community with TCEQ representatives in attendance.

Based on this information, staff is requesting Council to consider a resolution opposing the subject permit for the proposed domestic wastewater treatment facility.
