Consider, and act upon, the approval of the purchase of four (4) LUCAS 3 Chest Compression Systems in the estimated amount of \$113,848.93 through a cooperative purchasing contract with Sourcewell and authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents.

Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

Discussion

Wylie Fire Rescue would like to purchase four LUCAS 3 automatic CPR devices from Stryker. Automated CPR devices provide dedicated, quality compressions when treating CPR victims.

LUCAS 3 Chest Compression Systems are utilized with the most critical patient that Wylie Fire Rescue encounters. Quality compressions and early defibrillation are two of the strongest determinants of patient outcomes in cardiac arrest. It is nearly impossible to maintain continually effective compressions due to moving the patient, rescuer fatigue, and many other factors. The automatic CPR device will remove some of the barriers to continuous, effective compressions and therefore provide the best patient outcomes possible for the communities that Wylie Fire Rescue serves.

Staff recommends the purchase of the LUCAS 3 Chest Compression Systems in the estimated amount of \$113,848.93 through a cooperative purchasing contract with Sourcewell. The City is authorized to purchase from a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or a local cooperative organization pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Section 271 Subchapter F of the Local Government Code; and by doing so satisfies any State Law requiring local governments to seek competitive bids for items.
