Consider, and act upon, the acceptance of the resignation of Mark Booth, and appoint a board member to the Wylie Board of Review to fill the term from September 22, 2026, to June 30 2028, and appoint an alternate board member to the Wylie Board of Review to fill the term from September 22, 2026, to June 30 2027.

Recommendation

Motion to accept the resignation of Mark Booth and to appoint _____ to the Wylie Board of Review to fill the term from September 22, 2026 to June 30, 2028 and to appoint _____ as an alternate board member to the Wylie Board of Review to fill the term from September 22, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

Discussion

[Per Chapter 2 \(Administration\), Article III \(Officers\), Division 2 \(Code of Conduct\), Section 2-58\(a-2\) \(Board of Review\) of the Wylie Code of Ordinances](#), prospective Board of Review members shall be interviewed and appointed by a majority of the City Council present at a duly called meeting. Council interviewed three out of the five applicants.

Staff has received Mark Booth's resignation and requests Council appoint a member to fill the remaining term. Council may move an alternate board member up or appoint a new board member. If Council appoints an alternate board member, it must also appoint a new board member to fill the alternate's remaining term.

Staff has reached out to the applicants below, and four applicants confirmed they are still interested and eligible to serve.

Alternates:

- Chris Smith, Alternate – began term in August 2025, expires June 30, 2027
- Bonnie Tinsley, Alternate – began term in June 2026, expires June 30, 2027
