Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2026-19(R) to amend Resolution No. 2026-10(R) authorizing the City Manager to execute an Advanced Funding Agreement between the City of Wylie and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the On-System Highway Safety Improvement Project along FM 544 from McCreary Road to State Highway 78, clarifying the Texas Department of Transportation's responsibility for project cost overruns.

Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

Discussion

The City of Wylie was previously selected for the TxDOT 2023 Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Call for Projects. Kimley-Horn designed the project to include illumination and signal improvements along the FM 544 corridor from McCreary Road to State Highway 78 and submitted the plans to TxDOT on behalf of the City.

Staff is requesting to amend Resolution No. 2026-10(R) approved on July 14, 2026, and enter into an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) with TxDOT to facilitate the construction of these improvements. This amendment is necessary to clarify the funding responsibilities associated with the project, specifically that TxDOT will be responsible for any construction cost overruns exceeding the predetermined project allocations.

Part 1 of the construction project includes improved illumination along the FM 544 corridor in the amount of \$2,113,366.49, consisting of \$1,653,939.90 in federal participation and \$459,426.59 in state participation. Should construction costs exceed the predetermined funding allocation, TxDOT will be responsible for those overages. Part 2 of the project includes signal improvements at signalized intersections along the FM 544 corridor in the estimated amount of \$578,524.99, consisting of \$455,549.40 in federal participation and \$122,975.59 in state participation. Should construction costs exceed the predetermined funding allocation, TxDOT will be responsible for those overages.

Staff recommends amending the previously approved Resolution and entering into this Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the construction of improved illumination and signal improvements along FM 544 from McCreary Road to State Highway 78.
