Subject

Consider, and act upon, an amendment approving a Second Amendment to W2023-89-A On-Demand Ridesharing Public Private Partnership Program between the City of Wylie and TRIPPP Consulting, LLC, and authorizing the City Manager to execute any necessary documents.

Recommendation

Motion to approve the Item as presented.

Discussion

On September 26, 2023 the City executed Agreement W2023-89-A with TRIPPP Consulting to provide a Ridesharing Public Private Partnership to provide a transit program to serve the City of Wylie.

Since the inception of the Ride Awake Wylie Rideshare program, staff and TRIPPP have continued to collaborate to enhance the overall program. On September 24, 2024 Amendment No. 1 was executed in an effort to clarify that TRIPPP, as an independent contractor, may utilize other Subcontractor(s), including Transportation Network Company(s), for the Program. The Amendment removed Maruti ("Maruti") as a Subcontractor to provide On Demand Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Service ("paratransit") for the Project.

The program has been well received, consistently utilized, and continues to experience meaningful growth. As demand increases, we are evaluating opportunities to further strengthen and expand the program to meet the community's mobility needs. Amendment No. 2 is being proposed to meet those needs.

In summary, the proposed changes are as follows:

1. Rider fee shall increase from \$4.00 per ride to \$5.00 per ride.
2. UberX Share shall be the priority type of Uber product available for vouchers.
3. Total vouchers per month per rider shall be 12.
