Discussion

The Parks and Recreation Department budgeted for the replacement of outdated playground equipment located at the Birmingham Farms Park. This playground received significant damage during the 2016 hail storm, and staff has had to remove several components due to safety concerns. The new proposed playground will consist of modular structures for 2-5-year old children and 5-12-year children. In addition, a new arch two-bay swing set will be installed consisting of four different swings.

Staff recommends the purchase of playground equipment and installation services from The PlayWell Group, Inc. in the amount of \$59,525.97 as providing the best value to the City. The City is authorized to purchase from a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or a local cooperative organization pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Section 271 Subchapter F of the Local Government Code; and by doing so satisfies any State Law requiring local governments to seek competitive bids for items.
