Senior Planner Molina stated that the applicant was requesting for a variance to Section 5.5.D of the Subdivision Regulations Ordiance 2003-03 to allow for a retaining wall within a utility easement. The applicant has verified that there are not any utilities where he is planning on having the retaining wall. He explained that the purpose for the applicant wanting the retaining wall is to preserve his property and so that his children can play in the backyard. The Home Owner's Association has submitted a letter approving the retaining wall depending on the Cities response to the request. 33 notices were mailed out to surrounding property owners and received 5 responses in favor for the retaining wall.
