Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2022-08(R) authorizing the Interim City Manager of the City of Wylie, Texas, or his designee, to execute an Advance Funding Agreement between the State of Texas and the City of Wylie, and to take any and all other actions necessary to effectuate the same; and providing for an effective date hereof.

Recommendation

Discussion

Prior to beginning construction of FM 2514 (Parker Road), the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) requires the City of Wylie to move waterlines in conflict with the roadway plans. To meet the time constraints of the project and take advantage of the economy of scale of the TxDOT roadway project, City staff has worked with TxDOT on the subject Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) for the amount of \$575,110.83. This estimated amount developed by our consultant Grantham & Associates, Inc. is for the cost of TxDOT to construct the relocation of approximately 3,300 linear feet of existing 6-inch and 8-inch water line along Parker Road/North Ballard Avenue, between Brown Street and Paul Wilson Road. The replacement water line will be 8-inch in diameter.

Previously, a contract with Grantham and Associates, Inc. was approved for the design of this water relocation project and the construction plans are currently 100% complete. TxDOT must encumber the construction funding for this project by March of 2022 and the plans must be finalized by the Spring of 2022 for this project to be successful. The attached agreement will allow the project to continue without delay, including allowing TxDOT the ability to review the construction plans as the project progresses.
