RESOLUTION NO. 2024-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE TO EXTEND AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH LAFAYETTE CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT FOR ONE YEAR CONCERNING ASSISTANCE WITH VARIOUS MINOR MAINTENANCE ITEMS.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2022-14, adopted July 14, 2022, authorized the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Lafayette Consolidated Government concerning assistance with various minor maintenance items; and

WHEREAS, Youngsville occasionally needs to perform certain minor maintenance improvements within the corporate limits of the City but also within the Parish of Lafayette that may consist of, but not limited to, road grading, asphalt/concrete patching, ditch grading, culvert flushing, drainage structure repairs and other miscellaneous items which can be characterized as minor in nature, but lacks the equipment and manpower to accomplish such maintenance improvements; and

WHEREAS, there is a public purpose for this Agreement of substantial benefit to LCG, Youngsville, and the citizens of the City of Youngsville and the Parish of Lafayette.

WHEREAS, Youngsville and Lafayette Consolidated Government desires to extend this Intergovernmental Agreement for the assistance with various minor maintenance items for one year ending September 12, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Youngsville, Parish of Lafayette, Louisiana, does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Youngsville to extend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Lafayette Consolidated Government for one year pertaining to assistance with various minor maintenance items within the corporate limits of Youngsville.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
