RESOLUTION NO. 2025-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE AUTHORIZING & DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE AND LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT FOR SURFACE IMPROVEMENTS TO S. LARRIVIERE ROAD: LA 92 - CHEMIN METAIRIE.

WHEREAS, the City of Youngsville (City) and Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government (LCG), each have responsibilities for the flow, road conditions and public safety into and out of their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Youngsville is presently undertaking roadway improvements with associated drainage to facilitate the improvements on S. Larriviere Rd: LA 92-Chemin Metairie, which Project shall greatly benefit the motoring public who reside and work within Youngsville and in Lafayette Parish; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the roadway to be improved is within the corporate limits of the City of Youngsville, and a portion is within the unincorporated area of Lafayette Parish, and accordingly, the officials of Youngsville and LCG desire to share the costs and expenses associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and LCG desire to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement to set forth each party's responsibilities as to the Project.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Youngsville City Council, that the Mayor of the City of Youngsville is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with LCG to provide for the joint pursuit and completion of road and drainage improvements to S. Larriviere Rd: LA 92-Chemin Metairie.
