RESOLUTION NO. 2024-21

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE OF THE LATE EARL MENARD AND NAMING THE YOUNGSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PATROL CENTER AS THE “CHIEF EARL MENARD PATROL CENTER”.

WHEREAS, the late Earl Menard faithfully served the citizens of the City of Youngsville as Chief of Police from January 1, 1987 through December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, during his years of service, Chief Earl Menard demonstrated unwavering dedication, integrity, and commitment to the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of his exemplary public service and enduring legacy, the City Council of the City of Youngsville deems it fitting to honor Chief Earl Menard by naming the Youngsville Police Department Patrol Center as the “Chief Earl Menard Patrol Center”.

WHEREAS, the Patrol Center is located at 304 Fourth Street and currently serves as the hub of patrol.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Youngsville, Parish of Lafayette, Louisiana, does hereby recognize the distinguished service of the late Earl Menard and naming the Youngsville Police Department Patrol Center as the “Chief Earl Menard Patrol Center”.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a suitable marker or plaque shall be placed at said building designating its name accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Clerk and Recorder of the Parish of Lafayette for recordation in the Conveyance Records of said office.
