RESOLUTION NO. 2025-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE TO EXECUTE A WATER AND SEWER AGREEMENT WITH ST. MARTIN PARISH GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER SERVICES TO AN UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF METAIRIE PLACE SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, and the City of Youngsville amended a Wholesale Water Agreement on June 25, 2024 to allow Youngsville to supply water services outside of its corporate limits, to include the lots within Metairie Place Subdivision that lie outside of the City limits; and

WHEREAS, St. Martin Parish and the City of Youngsville wishes to enter into an agreement to allow Youngsville to provide water and sewer service to those lots that partially or completely lie within the jurisdictional limits of St. Martin Parish, namely Lots 38-49, Metairie Place, Phase 3, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council for the City of Youngsville does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Youngsville to execute a Water & Sewer Agreement with St. Martin Parish Government to provide water and sewer service to an unincorporated portion of Metairie Place Subdivision.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documentation associated with this Agreement.
