AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 497-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE AMENDING THE 2024-2025 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,575,791 TO RE-ALLOCATE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Youngsville, Louisiana, in general session convened that:

- SECTION 1. On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), which established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund.
- SECTION 2. The City of Youngsville received \$5,447,168.67 in ARPA funding.
- SECTION 3. These funds must be used to address eligible costs incurred from March 3, 2021 onward. Funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024 and expended by December 31, 2026.
- SECTION 5. These funds must be spent for purposes authorized by the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, and the City of Youngsville must comply with all applicable federal and state budgeting, accounting, contracting, reporting, and other compliance requirements for the use of these funds.
- SECTION 6. The Mayor for the City of Youngsville recommends amending the 2024-2025 Budget in the amount \$4,575,791 to re-allocate funding from the Youngsville Municipal Complex and Downtown Street and Pump Station #4 Upgrade Projects to Salaries & Wages.
- SECTION 7: That this ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.

This Ordinance having been introduced on November 14, 2024, and published by title only giving Notice of a Public Hearing on December 12, 2024, was submitted to a vote and the vote thereon was as follows:
