

**AMENDMENT TO WHOLESALE WATER AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT  
AND CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE, LOUISIANA**

LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT (“LCG”), herein appearing by and through its Mayor-President, Monique B. Boulet, duly authorized by Ordinance No. CO - \_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_ adopted by the Lafayette City Council, and the CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE, LOUISIANA (“YOUNGSVILLE”), herein appearing by and through its Mayor, Ken Ritter, duly authorized by Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_ of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Youngsville, Louisiana, do hereby agree as follows:

1. LCG and YOUNGSVILLE have an existing Wholesale Water Agreement with a forty (40) -year term, originally entered into on December 24, 1998, recorded as Act No. 98-055657 in the records of the Lafayette Parish Clerk of Court (the “Agreement”).
2. The Agreement, among other things, provides that YOUNGSVILLE shall, during the term of the Agreement, purchase all of its water supply requirements necessary to serve all of its retail and wholesale customers within its corporate limits, as those limits may be expanded from time to time.
3. During the term of the Agreement, Metairie Place Subdivision (the “Subdivision”) has been developed. The majority of the Subdivision is within the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE and will be provided water service by YOUNGSVILLE with wholesale water purchased from LCG in accordance with the Agreement. However, a portion of the Subdivision is located outside of the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE and is unlikely to be incorporated into the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE.
4. It is impractical and inefficient for the portion of the Subdivision that is not within the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE to be provided water service by any other provider than YOUNGSVILLE. However, because this portion of the Subdivision is outside of the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE, water service to this area is currently outside the permissible service territory and the scope of the Agreement.
5. LCG and YOUNGSVILLE now desire to amend the Agreement to provide for the sale by LCG and the purchase by YOUNGSVILLE of all of YOUNGSVILLE’s water supply requirements necessary to serve the portion of the Subdivision that is not located within the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE.
6. Considering the foregoing, the Agreement is hereby amended to expand the geographic area included within the Agreement (specifically including, but not limited to, the original Exhibit “A” to the Agreement, all subsequent versions of Exhibit “A” submitted pursuant to Section I(1) of the Agreement, and all areas annexed into YOUNGSVILLE during the term of the Agreement) to include the portion of the Subdivision that is not located within the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE, as shown on the attached Exhibit \_\_\_\_.
7. All terms and conditions of the Agreement shall apply to the area depicted in Exhibit \_\_\_\_ to the same extent as other geographic areas included within the Agreement.
8. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
