

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO A WHOLESALE WATER AGREEMENT WITH LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO AN UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF METAIRIE PLACE SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated (“LCPCG”) and the City of Youngsville (“YOUNGSVILLE”) entered into the Wholesale Water Agreement dated December 24, 1998 whereby the LCPCG provides potable water to YOUNGSVILLE for the purpose of reselling to YOUNGSVILLE’s retail and wholesale customers; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement, among other things, provides that YOUNGSVILLE shall, during the term of the Agreement, purchase all of its water supply requirements necessary to serve all of its retail and wholesale customers within its corporate limits, as those limits may be expanded from time to time; and

WHEREAS, during the term of the Agreement, Metairie Place Subdivision (the “SUBDIVISION”) has been developed with a portion of the SUBDIVISION located outside of the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE and is unlikely to be incorporated into the corporate limits of YOUNGSVILLE; and

WHEREAS, both entities desire to amend the Agreement to include the unincorporated portion of the SUBDIVISION.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council for the City of Youngsville does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Youngsville to execute an amendment to a Wholesale Water Agreement with Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to provide service to an unincorporated portion of Metairie Place Subdivision.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documentation associated with this amended Agreement.
